

A Guide to Prayer for the Lenten Season, Week 3

We Are a Family of Families

How is God calling *you* to lead your family? (Romans 8:14-17)

Praise the Father

“Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name!” You are God. No matter what happens, you are **STILL** on the throne. I want to Praise you always. (Matthew 6:9)

Request the Kingdom

“Your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.” When your answer is ‘no’ I need your help to accept the ‘no’ and depend on you much, much more. (Matthew 6:10)

Ask for Provision

“Give us this day our daily bread.” When I feel that my prayers are unanswered, remind me that you are providing for me even though I may not see it. (Matthew 6:11)

Yield Your Sins to God

“...And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.” Father, as I remember the debt I owe you, help me to gift forgiveness to others. Forgiveness is available to all! (Matthew 6:12)

Engage the Enemy

“...And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.” I thank you for delivering all your children from harm, even when we don’t recognize that we need rescued! (Matthew 6:13a)

Rejoice in God’s Victory

“For yours is the kingdom, and the power and the glory forever. Amen!” Thank you for all that you have allowed and not allowed in my life. Continue to remind me that your decisions for me lead to victory! (Matthew 6:13b)

God is On the Throne

Gracious Father in Heaven, help me to understand your kingly attributes. You are Majestic, Eternal, Holy, Omnipotent, Unique, and you are Good! Lead me to trust in you in a new way. (Matthew 6:33)
